6th Grade

Give these items to Homeroom Teacher: 3 boxes tissues, 1 package 24 count pencils, 1 package 24 count colored pencils, 1 pack loose-leaf paper (college ruled)

Each student will also need: 2 pkgs. loose leaf paper, 1 pencil case to carry from class to class, ear buds, (3) 1" 3 ring binders for Science, Social Studies and Language Arts, (2) one subject notebooks, 1 composition notebook for LA, (4) 2 pocket folders for Reading, small 3-hole punch to carry from class to class, (1) pkg. red pens, (1) pkg. blue or black pens, 1 pkg. highlighters, (1) pkg. of 4 dry erase markers, (2) large glue sticks, (1) bottle of glue, (3) pkgs. of tabbed dividers... (1) 6 count, (2) 5 count, 1 scissor

7th Grade

Social Studies – 1 composition notebook, 1 sturdy folder, colored pencils or markers, 2 glue sticks, scissors, loose leaf paper, **OPTIONAL Supplies that may be useful:** ear buds, stylus, colorful construction paper

Math – 2 – 24 pack pencils, 2 – dry erase markers (fine point), 1 spiral notebook, loose leaf paper, 2"–3" binder, highlighters, pens, colored pencils

Science – 1" 3-ring binder w/inside pockets, composition bound notebook (not spiral), pencils/pens, dividers for binder (pack of 5) **OPTIONAL Supplies:** stylus (for iPad), poster board(s) (keep at home), colored pencils, pencil case (to keep in binder)
